2 02-12-2025 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 96, 352,
351(2), and 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and Section
3(i)(r) of SC/ST Act and later on Section 8/12 of POCSO Act
has been added.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is a person with clean antecedent and the informant
alleges that Nitish in connivance with his family members
kidnapped the minor daughter of the informant aged about 16
years on 14-7-2025.



4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the instant case by the informant being uncle of Nitish. It is next submitted that victim came back and her statement was recorded under Section 183 BNSS, wherein she has not supported the case of the prosecution.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned trial court within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Bikramganj P.S. Case No. 494 of 2025, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482 (2) of the BNSS.
