- 2 18-01-2025 **1.** Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.
- 2.** The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 324,
307, 302, 120B and 504 of the Indian Penal Code.
- 3.** The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
the petitioner had approached this Court seeking regular bail by
filing Cr. Misc No. 27561 of 2024 and the same was dismissed
by an order dated 21-09-2024 with a liberty to the petitioner to
renew his prayer for bail after framing of charge. It is next
submitted that charges against the petitioner have been framed on
23-02-2024 (Annexure-6).
- 4.** Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for
bail of the petitioner.



5. Considering the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, let the petitioner above named be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty-five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Laukaha P.S. Case No. 83 of 2023.

6. However, if the learned trial court comes to a conclusion that the petitioner after his release is trying to delay the trial in any manner, the learned trial court shall forthwith cancel his bail bonds after recording reasons.
