petitioners and learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in connection with Gardanibagh P.S. Case No. 469/2025 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 191(2)/191(3)/190/111(2)/126(2)/127(2)/115(2)/109/121(2)/132/324(4)/351(2)/352 of BNS.

3. As per the allegation made in the F.I.R., the petitioners along with 150-200 persons armed with sticks, rods and stones are said to have blocked the road, damaged vehicles, caused traffic jam and assaulted the police party in course of protest due to death of a student.



4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have falsely been implicated in the case. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus. The F.I.R. reveals that 150-180 persons were involved in the incident, at best, the petitioners can be said to be the member of the mob.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners.

6. Considering the nature of allegation made against the petitioners and the fact that the petitioners happen to be the member of the mob, the petitioners, above named, are directed to be released on pre-arrest bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned District Court where the case is pending in connection with Gardanibagh P.S. Case No. 469/2025, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C / 482(2) BNSS.

7. The District Court is directed to verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioners and if it is found that the petitioners



are involved in some other cases as what has been stated in
Para-3 of the bail petition, this order will automatically lose its
force.

8. The bail application stands disposed of.
