ORAL ORDER

2 05-12-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Amarpur P.S. Case No. 10/2025 dated 04.01.2025 corresponding to G.R. No. 33/2025, Reg. No. 695/2025 registered for the offences punishable u/ss 310(4), 310(5), 132, 109(1) and 111 of the B.N.S. and Sections 25(1-B)(a), 26, 27 and 35 of the Arms Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, a country-made musket and 17 live cartridges were recovered from the possession of the co-accused, Shiv Shakti Yadav and a double barrel gun along with two live cartridges and one empty cartridge was recovered from the possession of the co-accused, Pankaj Kumar Saw when



the petitioner along with other co-accused persons were assembled to commit crime.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The apprehended person disclosed the name of the petitioner. The other co-accused person has already been granted bail by this court vide order dated 20.08.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 57039/2025. The petitioner has six antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 18.04.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Banka in connection with Amarapur P.S. Case No. 10/2025, with the condition ;-

(i). The petitioner is directed to remain physically



present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to be cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
