Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case in connection with Ram Das Rai Ka Dera P.S. Case No. 33 of 2025 dated 12.07.2025 registered for the offence/s punishable u/ss 80(2), 85 of the BNS.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner and the co-accused persons are alleged to have killed the informant's daughter due to non-fulfillment of demand of dowry.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner is the mother-in-law of the deceased. The petitioner neither demanded any dowry nor tortured the



informant. There is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated at para 3 of the bail petition.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the anticipatory bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the allegation being general and omnibus, let the above named petitioner, in the event of his arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned, Buxar in connection with Ram Das Rai Ka Dera P.S. Case No. 33 of 2025, subject to conditions as laid down under section 482(2) of the BNSS.

8. The application stands allowed.
