2 20-11-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Lalmania P.S. Case No. 49 of 2025 dated 31.08.2025 G.R. No.
533 of 2025, instituted for the offences punishable under
Sections 274, 275 B.N.S. and Section 30(a) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that 61.8 liters of
Nepali liquor was recovered from motorcycle and petitioner was
arrested on spot.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
present case. No incriminating material has been recovered from



the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has got no concern with the alleged recovery of liquor. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that local people disclosed the name of the petitioner. Petitioner's name has transpired only on the basis of suspicion. The petitioner is in custody since 01.09.2025 and has got clean antecedent. There is no compliance of Section 103 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, clean antecedent of the petitioner and the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Lalmania P.S. Case No. 49 of 2025 dated 31.08.2025 G.R. No. 533 of 2025.
