2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Kotwali (Jogsar) P.S. Case No. 16 of 2019, registered for
the offences punishable under Sections 366(A) and 34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the allegation, the petitioner and other
accused persons have kidnapped the informant's daughter.

4. Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that
