ORAL ORDER

2 24-11-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners seek bail in G.R. No. 1537/2025 arising out of Mansoorchak P.S. case No. 105 of 2025 instituted for the offences under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that 825 liters liquor was recovered from truck and the petitioners were arrested on spot.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case. No incriminating material has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners. The petitioners



have got no concern with the alleged recovery of liquor. It is further submitted that the petitioners have got no concern with the vehicles. The petitioners were passerby of the way and have become victim of circumstances at the instance of police merely on the basis of suspicion. The petitioners are in custody since 08.10.2025 and have got one criminal antecedent each. There is no compliance of Section 103 of B.N.S.S., 2023.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioners.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody undergone by the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

7. Let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.15,000/- (Fifteen thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with G.R. No. 1537/2025 arising out of Mansoorchak P.S. case No. 105 of 2025.
