2. The petitioner has prayed for bail in connection
with Muffasil P.S. Case No. 188 of 2025 registered for the
offence punishable under Sections 111(2), 111(4) and 3(5) of
B.N.S., Section 25(1-A), 25(1-AA), 25(1-B)(a), 25(1-B)(c),
26(1), 26(2) and 35 of the Arms Act.

3. The case of the prosecution, in short, is that at the
house of Md. Shabir Hasan @ Tipu huge quantity of illegal
arms along with equipment for manufacturing arms, iron
magazine, cartridges and smart phone was recovered and the
apprehended accused disclosed the name of this petitioner.



4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from his possession. His name has surfaced only in the confessional statement of the co-accused. It has also been submitted that similarly situated co-accused Md. Sonu @ Sajid Alam whose name has also surfaced in the confessional statement of Md. Shabbir Hasan @ Tipu has been granted bail by learned Co-ordinate Bench vide Cr. Misc. No. 54628 of 2025. Petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 05.07.2025.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State has vehemently opposed the application for bail and has submitted that the petitioner is having criminal antecedent of one case of similar nature.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Munger in connection with Muffasil P.S. Case No. 188 of 2025.



7. The petitioner is directed to cooperate in the trial
and to be present in the Court whenever required.
