2 31-01-2025 Heard learned counsels for the parties.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 307, 332, 333, 353, 153(A), 295(A), 296, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the FIR, when the police party tried to pacify a quarrel arose between two community during Muharram procession, the accused persons including the petitioners assaulted the police party due to which they sustained injuries.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The



allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. There is no specific overt act against the petitioners. It is further submitted that similarly situated co-accused persons have been granted bail by this Court in Cr. Misc. No.29168 of 2024. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) **each** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Dumaria P.S. Case No.84 of 2023, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
