2. This is second anticipatory bail petition. Earlier the petition, filed for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of petitioner, stood dismissed as withdrawn, vide order dated 26.07.2024 passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court in Cr.Misc. No. 32313/2024 (Annexure P/1).

3. The present petition does not reveal any change of circumstance or new ground.

4. In view of the fact that no fresh ground has been pressed for consideration of pre-arrest bail as well as in view of the recent judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *G.R. Ananda Babu Vs. State of Tamil Nadu and Anr.*, reported in *2021 SCC Online SC 176*, the second anticipatory



bail petition is not maintainable. It is, accordingly, dismissed.
