“1(a). For a direction to the concerned Respondent authorities to remove encroachment from the Chailaha Minor Canal in the facts and circumstances of this case.



- (b). For a direction to the concerned Respondent authorities to revive and restore the Chailaha Minor Canal into its actual alignment as per the original map of the canal.
- (c). For a direction to the concerned Respondent authorities to establish Bandobasti in favour of the petitioner in the facts and circumstances of this case.”

- 2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Circle Officer, Banjariya, East Champaran, for redressal of his aforesaid grievance. Liberty so sought, is granted.
