ORAL ORDER

2 05-02-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Rajepur P.S. Case No. 180 of 2024 dated 07.09.2024 registered for the offences punishable u/s 309(4) of the B.N.S.

3. As per the prosecution case, three unknown miscreants are alleged to have stopped the informant's motorcycle and looted the amount of Rs. 1,81,580/-, key of the bike, documents of the company, Oppo phone and Aadhar Card and fled away from the spot.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in



this case. The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. The name of the petitioner has sprung up in the confessional statement of the co-accused, Dhananjay Kumar. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. It is further submitted that the petitioner has no concern with the alleged offence. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 10.09.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Rajepur P.S. Case No. 180 of 2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
