on behalf of the petitioner and Mrs. Shaheen Begum, learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in connection
with Samastipur Excise P.S. Case No. 258 of 2025 registered for
the offence punishable under Section 30 (a) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act as amended up-to-date.

3. Allegation is of recovery of 21.960 litres of illicit
foreign liquor from the house of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner submits that due to enmity, the petitioner has been
planted in a false case. Petitioner has no concern with the
alleged seized liquor nor he is involved in trade of liquor in any
manner. He further submitted that that petitioner resides in a
joint family and some other members of the family may have
hid the liquor. Petitioner has clean antecedent. On these



grounds, petitioner seeks to be released on pre-arrest bail.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the rival submissions made on behalf of the parties, as well as, the nature of allegation made in the FIR, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on pre-arrest bail, in the event of his/her arrest or surrender before the learned District Court within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned District Court where the case is pending, in connection with Samastipur Excise P.S. Case No. 258 of 2025, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.

7. The learned District Court is directed to verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner as stated in paragraph no. 3 of the bail application. If any other case is pending against the petitioner as what has been stated in paragraph no. 3, this order will lose its force automatically.

8. The present bail application is disposed of.
