3 27-01-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, informant
and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Sections 80 and 3(5) of the B.N.S.

3. Petitioner along with other accused persons are said
to have committed murder of the daughter of the informant due
to non-fulfillment of demand of dowry.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this
case. He submits that the petitioner is the husband of the
deceased on that basis he has been made accused in this case.
He submits that there is specific overt act against the petitioner.
He submits that on the alleged date and time of occurrence, the
petitioner was not present there rather he is doing job in the city
of Kolkata for his livelihood. He further submits that petitioner



has no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of the bail application and he is languishing in judicial custody since 27.08.2024.

5. Learned APP for the State and informant oppose the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the nature of offence, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, his prayer for bail is rejected in connection with Mehshi P.S. Case No. 112 of 2024.

7. However, the petitioner is at liberty to renew his prayer for bail after framing of charge.
