appellant and Ms.Usha Kumari 1, learned Spl.P.P. for the State.

Learned Spl.P.P. for the State has taken a preliminary objection with regard to maintainability of the present appeal on the ground that the learned court had taken cognizance in the present case on 24.06.2024 and in view of the provisions under the SC/ST Act, the present anticipatory bail is not maintainable.

3. Learned counsel for the appellant seeks permission to withdraw this appeal with liberty to the appellant to surrender before the learned court below within a period of two weeks from today and seek regular bail.

4. Permission is accorded.



5. The application is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty that the appellant surrenders and seeks regular bail before the learned court below, the same shall be considered on the same day on its own merit in accordance with law and without being prejudiced by any observation in the present order and taking into consideration that earlier the police has submitted final form in favour of the appellant.
