ORAL ORDER

- 2 24-01-2025 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned A.P.P. for the State.
2. The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Excise Act.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has antecedent of one case and allegation is of recovery of 165 liters of liquor from a road near a temple.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was not apprehended from the spot as such nothing was recovered from his conscious possession and even the alleged recovery is from a place which does not belong to the petitioner and is accessible to public at large. It is next submitted that petitioner came to be implicated at the instance of



Chowkidar, but then it is submitted that in majority of the cases police implicates accused persons either at the instance of *Chowkidar*, local person, secret information or confessional statement in a mechanical manner without holding a proper investigation. It is next submitted that petitioner is in custody since 04.09.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner above-named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Mahuawa P.S. Case No. 07 of 2024.
