ORAL ORDER

2 12-12-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Special
Case No. 35A of 2025, arising out of Sukhani P.S. Case No. 38
of 2025 instituted for the offence under Sections 8, 8(c), 20(b)
(ii)(B) & 21(a) of the NDPS Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, it is alleged that on
secret information, the house of Vishal Gupta was raided,
whereupon two persons were arrested and upon search, there
was recovery of DD Kit test, 18 bottles of 300 mL wine, 1.220
Kg of ganja and 1.63 gram smack.

4. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner
that the petitioner is in custody since 30.08.2025. Petitioner



bears six criminal antecedents, as per disclosure made in paragraph No. 3 of the bail application.

5. It has been further submitted by the petitioner's counsel that petitioner, being a lady, has been falsely implicated in the present case. Petitioner is not named in the FIR. Name of the petitioner has surfaced in this case on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused, Vishal Kumar. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Other co-accused has been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 27-08-2025, passed in Cr. Misc. No. 57433 of 2025.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, period of custody of the petitioner, petitioner being a lady and claim based on parity, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

8. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- (Fifteen Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Special Case No. 35A of 2025, arising out of Sukhani P.S. Case No. 38 of 2025,



subject to the following conditions:

(I) One of the bailors shall be own/close member of the family of the petitioner.

(II) The petitioner shall appear on each and every date fixed at the trial. In case of default in such appearance on two consecutive dates, the Trial Court will have liberty to cancel the bail bonds of the petitioner.
