2 12-02-2025 Heard learned Counsel for the petitioner and
learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Bangra P.S. Case No. 115 of 2024, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 305, 317(2) and 331(4) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023.

3. As per allegation, the informant and his family members sleeping in the *verandah* of the house. The accused persons including the petitioner entered into the house of the informant and stolen some ornaments and Rs. One lakh cash.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. Nothing has been recovered from his



possession and his name has figured on confessional statement of co-accused.

5. On the other hand, learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the above-mentioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks before the learned court below, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate-1st Class, Samastipur in connection with Bangra P.S. Case No. 115 of 2024, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
