2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that
as per the direction given by this Court dated 01.09.2023 passed



in Miscellaneous Jurisdiction Case No. 4548/2019 in Civil Writ Jurisdiction Case. No. 13201/2014 i.e. Annexure-P/4, all the petitioners made their representation before the respondent no. 02 vide Annexure-P/12 dated 11.12.2023 but till today no decision has been taken by the concerned respondent. Therefore, it is prayed by the counsel that this petition may be disposed of, directing the respondent no. 02 to consider and decided the pending representation of the petitioners, Annexure P/12 within any specific period fixed by this Court.
