a writ petition bearing C.W.J.C. No.4786 of 2015, which has

stood dismissed on account of non-prosecution, by an order

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that

the main counsel, who had filed the aforesaid writ petition,

although the present counsel was also a signatory to the

pandemic, hence the case could not be marked on the day the

same was listed, resulting in dismissal of the aforesaid writ
