This appeal has been filed for setting aside order dated 20.08.2024 passed in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 191 (2), 126 (2), 115 (2), 308 (2), 308 (2), 303 (2), 324 (4), 132 and 121 (1) of the Indian Penal Code and sections 3(i) (r) (s) / 3 (2) (iii) (va) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Act, whereby the prayer for anticipatory bail of the appellant has been rejected.

3 . As per the prosecution case , informant namely, Pappu Kumar (SHO Shripur) alleged that these appellants



along with other co-accused persons named in the F.I.R. obstructed police officials in discharge of their official duty and abused informant by caste name and also damaged the police van .

4. Considering the fact that this appellant along with other co-accused persons abused informant by caste name , damaged police van and also hindered police officials in discharging their official duty , I do not find any reason to interfere with the impugned order, accordingly this appeal is dismissed.
