2 17-12-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel
for the informant and learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for bail in connection with
Laukaha P.S. Case No. 207 of 2024 registered for the offence
punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 117(2), 109,
303(2), 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of the B.N.S.

3. The case of the prosecution, in short, is that the
petitioner has assaulted with iron rod on the head of the informant
indiscriminately.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no
offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. The only
allegation against the petitioner is that he has assaulted with iron
rod indiscriminately on the head of the informant but from perusal
of the injury report, it is clear that the informant has received only



one injury on the head. It has further been submitted that there is no repetition of the blow as alleged by the informant. Had there been repetition of blow on head could not have been only one injury. There is land dispute between the parties and a case has been filed by the petitioner side in year 2020. Petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 08.10.2025.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State and learned counsel for the informant have vehemently opposed the application for bail and has submitted that petitioner is having criminal antecedent of four cases.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M., Jhanjharpur, Madhubani in connection with Laukha P.S. Case No. 207 of 2024 **with the condition that the petitioner shall cooperate in the trial and shall be present in the trial Court whenever required.**
