2. The present writ petition has been filed for the

*(i) To issue an appropriate order/s,

of Certiorari for quashing the order dated
10.10.2019 passed in connection with Mutation
Case No.483 of 2019-2020 passed by the Circle
Officer, Morwan whereby and whereunder he has
passed the order of Mutation of land measuring an*



area 2.17 decimal. A pertaining to Khata No.111, Plot No.1040 situated in Mauza- Dharmpur Bande, P.S.- Patory, District- Samastipur in favour of the respondents No.6.
