ORAL ORDER

2 08-01-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in Piro P.S. Case No. 514
of 2023, instituted for the offences punishable under Sections
380 and 454 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that, while the
informant went to market, five accused persons, including the
petitioner entered into the house of the informant and it is
alleged that they have looted gold ornaments from the house of



the informant.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. Charge-sheet has been submitted in this case. No incriminating material has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner also submitted that informant and petitioner are neighbours. The petitioner has no knowledge about the alleged occurrence and has no concern with the alleged occurrence. The petitioner is in custody since 10.12.2023 and has got no criminal antecedent. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that similarly situated co-accused has been granted regular bail by this Court *vide* order dated 25.10.2024 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 60015 of 2024.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and taking into account the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two



sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court
below/concerned Court in connection with Piro P.S. Case No.
514 of 2023.
