2. This is the second attempt on behalf of the petitioner for grant of bail in connection with Fatehpur P.S. Case No. 710 of 2023 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 302 and 201 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

3. Earlier the bail application of the petitioner has been rejected vide order dated 17.02.2024 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 5895 of 2024, which reads as under:

“Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Fatehpur P.S. Case No. 710 of 2023 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 302 and 201 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.



3. As per the prosecution case, the deceased was killed by contract killers.

4. The petitioner is involved in conspiracy of hiring the contract killers. The petitioner is in jail since 28.09.2023 and materials have come during investigation to connect the petitioner with the crime.

5. Accordingly, this application is dismissed.

6. The Court below is directed to expedite the trial.”

4. In the trial, charge has been framed.

5. Considering the fact that the petitioner is a contract killers and has killed the accused, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the application stands dismissed.

7. The Senior Superintendent of Police, Gaya is directed to ensure the attendance of witnesses in the trial. If the trial is delayed by the prosecution, the petitioner may renew his prayer for bail.
