2 18-12-2025 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned counsel for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with
Janta Bazar P.S. Case No. 213 of 2025 registered for offences
under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. There is recovery of 05 liters of illicit country made
liquor from the spot. The petitioner claims clean antecedent.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is ready to donate Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten
Thousand Only) in some charitable organization without
accepting her guilt.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed
the prayer of the petitioner.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case



and the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner, this application for regular bail stands allowed.

7. Accordingly, let the petitioner, above-named, in the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise-III, Saran at Chapra/concerned Court below in connection with Janta Bajar P.S. Case No. 213 of 2025 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS and with further conditions that:-

(I). The petitioner shall deposit an amount of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only) in Ramakrishna Mission Ashrama, Latu Maharaj Path, Opp. Circuit House, Chapra and produce the receipt of the same before the Court below. The bail bonds of the petitioner shall be accepted after verifying the genuineness of the receipt produced by the petitioner.

(ii). The petitioner is directed to mark her attendance in Sikrahata Police Station on every Sunday of each month. Failure to do so, will result in cancellation of bail bond of the petitioner.
