2 09-01-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Narhat
P.S. Case No. 257 of 2024 instituted for the offence under
Sections 303(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3. Prosecution case in a nutshell is that Bolero car of
the informant was stolen by unknown miscreants which was
parked in front of his house.

4. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner
that the petitioner is in custody since 02-08-2024. Petitioner
bears two criminal antecedents, as per disclosure made in
paragraph No. 3 of the bail application.

5. It has been further submitted by the petitioner's



counsel that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. Petitioner is not named in the FIR. Name of the petitioner transpired during course of investigation on the basis of identification via CCTV footage. No incriminating article has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. It is submitted that the Bolero in question has been recovered from co-accused, namely, Haider Quraishi, on the basis of alleged self-confession statement of the petitioner. It is next submitted that there is no compliance of Section 103 of the BNSS, 2023. It is lastly submitted that charge sheet has been submitted in this case.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, period of custody of the petitioner and charge sheet being submitted, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

8. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Narhat P.S. Case No. 257 of 2024, subject to the following conditions:



(I) One of the bailors shall be own/close member of the family of the petitioner.

(II) The petitioner shall appear on each and every date fixed at the trial. In case of default in such appearance on two consecutive dates, the Trial Court will have liberty to cancel the bail bonds of the petitioner.
