2 10-02-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered
under Section 30(a) of Bihar Excise Act.

3. As per prosecution case, 38.37 liters illicit liquor has
been recovered from the house of co-accused Dipak Kumar who
is already in custody.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case only because petitioner is mother
of co-accused Dipak Kumar. Nothing has been recovered from
the conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner has got no
criminal antecedent of similar nature.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposed the prayer for bail.



6. Having considered the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of eight weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000 (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned First Exclusive Special Judge, Excise, Saran at Chapra, in connection with Dighwara P.S. Case No. 356 of 2024, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S., 2023.
