ORAL ORDER

2 19-02-2025 Heard Mr. Vijay Kumar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners and Mr. Anuj Kumar Shrivastava, learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in connection with Jamui P.S. Case No. 492 of 2024 registered for the offence(s) punishable under Sections 329(4), 115(2), 110, 352, 303(2), 3(5)of BNS.

3. As per the allegation made in the FIR, the accused persons named therein including the petitioners with a common intention assaulted the informant on different parts of his body including on his head.



4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case. There is case and counter case between the parties arising out of the same incidence and due to land dispute, an altercation took place and both the sides entered into fierce fight and in the self-defence, petitioners may have caused some injury on the person of the informant. General and omnibus allegation has been made against the petitioners and specific allegation of assaulting the informant by means of iron rod on the head of the informant is against co-accused Krishna Singh.

5. Learned APP for the State vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail.

6. Considering the nature of allegation made against the petitioners, as well as, the fact that there being case and counter case arising out of same incidence and general and omnibus allegation has been made against the petitioners, I am of the opinion that petitioners have, prima facie, made out a case to be released on pre-arrest bail.

7. The petitioners, above named, are directed to be released on pre-arrest bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks



from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Jamui in connection with Jamui P.S. Case No. 492 of 2024, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
