petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing

on behalf of the State.

2. The accused/petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

and apprehended his arrest in connection with Turkauliya P.S.

Case No. 383 of 2024 registered for the offences punishable

under Sections 274, 275 and 3(5) BNS and Section 30 (a) of

the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. The allegation against the petitioner is to be

engaged in illegal trading/manufacturing of illicit liquor,

where, there is recovery of 11 litres of IMFL/country made

liquor.



4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that name of petitioner transpired in the present case on the basis of disclosure made by Langda Paswan from whom illicit liquor was recovered and not from the physical possession of this petitioner. It is also submitted that petitioner found involved in three more criminal case, where he is on bail in all the cases.

5. Learned APP appearing on behalf of the State, opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. In view of the facts and circumstances and by taking note of the fact as recovery of illicit liquor *prima-facie* not appears to be made from the conscious physical possession of this petitioner, accordingly the petitioner above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks, is directed to be released on bail, furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge Excise Court No. 1, Motihari, East Champaran/concerned Court below where the case is pending in connection with



Turkauliya P.S. Case No. 383 of 2024 subject to the
conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
