ORAL ORDER

2 03-03-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Nawada (Nagar) P.S. Case No. 681 of 2021 dated 02.04.2021 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 33, 34 and 36 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, the informant's husband Omprakash Prasad @ Prakash Singh @ Lota Singh died due to consumption of spurious liquor which was purchased from some unknown persons.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is not named in the FIR. The name of the petitioner has transpired on the basis of confessional



statement of the co-accused, Manti Devi. The co-accused person has already been granted regular bail by this court vide order dated 01.08.2024 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 54635 of 2024. The petitioner is accused in 20 other criminal cases which are related to similar nature of offence as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 10.10.2022.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Nawada in connection with Nawada (Nagar) P.S. Case No. 681 of 2021 with the condition :-

(i) The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to be cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
