No. 248 of 2024) against pre emptory order dated 2.5.2024 by Hon'ble Justice Rajiv Roy was pleased to hear the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents stating that three weeks time is granted to learned counsel for the petitioners to remove the defects as pointed out by the office, failing which this application shall rejected without further reference to the Bench and the case to put up on 12.08.2024 as the matter is related with land acquisition on National Highway at Land Reforms, Bhabhua, District-Kaimuar (Bhabhua).
