2. The present application has been preferred:

of C.W.J.C. No. 1402 of 2024) against



peremptory order dated 25.4.2024 by Hon'ble Justice Rajiv Roy was pleased to hear the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents stating that three weeks time is granted to learned counsel for the petitioners to remove the defects as pointed out by the office, failing which this application shall be rejected without further reference to the Bench and the case to put up on 12.08.2024 as the matter is related with land acquisition on National Highway at Land Reforms, Bhabhua, District-Kaimuar (Bhabhua). And the petitioner is running from pillar to post for receiving the Award Money who are hand to mouth and on the verge of starvation accordingly the case is required to be restored to meet the ends of Justice failing which the
