learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Jogbani P.S. Case No. 108/2025 registered for the offences
punishable under Sections 8(c)/ 21(b) of the N.D.P.S. Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, 53 gms. of brown
sugar was recovered from the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case.
Learned counsel further submits that petitioner has four
criminal antecedents in which he is on bail and he is in
custody since 11.09.2025. The petitioner undertakes to co-



operate in the case/ trial. It is further submitted that co-accused has already been granted bail by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 03.12.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 83368 of 2025.

5. Learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the facts that co-accused has already been granted bail by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 03.12.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 83368 of 2025.and circumstances of the case, this application for regular bail is allowed.

7. Accordingly, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Sessions Judge-cum- Special Judge, N.D.P.S. Act, Araria /concerned Court below in connection with Jogbani P.S. Case No. 108 of 2025 subject to the conditions:-

(i) The petitioner after being released on bail, is directed to mark his attendance at Jogbani Police Station, District- Araria on every Sunday of the month. Any default



in appearance at the Police Station will result in
cancellation of bail bonds of the petitioner.

(ii) One of the bailors of the petitioner shall be his
close relative
