3 01-08-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

2. The present application has been filed for restoration of CWJC No. 5017 of 2016 to its original file.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide



order dated 08.08.2024 passed by this Court, the writ application bearing CWJC No. 5017 of 2016 was dismissed for default. Learned counsel further submits that there is no willful or deliberate absence of the petitioner on the three consecutive dates, rather the absence has been caused due to non-communication of the learned advocate on record with the petitioner. Learned counsel, therefore, prays that the present restoration application may be allowed.
