2. The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 115, 118(1), 117, 109, 103(1) and 3(5) of Bhartiya Nyay Sanhita.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner along with other co-accused persons is said to have gave fatal injuries to the deceased by deadly weapons with intention to kill him.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no such occurrence as alleged ever took place. He is quite innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. He submits that the petitioner is said to have assaulted the informant and the injury was found



simple in nature. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent and has been languishing in custody since 26.10.2024.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the bail petition.

6. Considering the facts aforesaid, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Panapur P.S. Case No.213 of 2024.
