ORAL ORDER

2 27-01-2025 Heard Dr. Anjani Pd. Singh, learned counsel for the
petitioner and Ms. Renu Kumari, learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Barbigaha PS Case No. 174 of 2024 instituted for the offences
under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that total 03 litres
of country made liquor was recovered from the house of the
petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
present case. No incriminating material has been recovered from
the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has got
no concern with the alleged recovery of liquor. It is submitted
that recovery is made from the joint house of the petitioner



where the other family members also reside. The petitioner is in custody since 19.11.2024 and has got two criminal antecedents in which he is on bail. There is no compliance of Section 103 of B.N.S.S. Petitioner has himself surrendered in the court below.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Barbigha PS Case No. 174 of 2024.
