ORAL ORDER

5 15-04-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned
APP for the State and perused the case diary.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Atri P.S. Case No. 337 of 2024, instituted for the offences punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 74, 109, 137(2), 87 and 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that, the petitioner kidnapped the daughter of the informant for the purpose of marriage and hit her on head.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. Charge-sheet has been submitted in this case. Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that there is



delay of three days in lodging the FIR. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is general and omnibus in nature. Statement of the victim recorded under Section 183 BNSS does not corroborate with the prosecution story. The victim has not stated anything specific against the petitioner. It is further submitted that the victim has denied for her medical examination. It is the petitioner who took the victim to the hospital for her treatment. The petitioner is in custody since 08.09.2024 and has got no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and taking into account the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Atri P.S. Case No. 337 of 2024, subject to the following conditions:

(I) One of the bailors shall be own/close member of the family of the petitioner.



(II) The petitioner shall appear on each and every date fixed at the trial. In case of default in such appearance on two consecutive dates, the Trial Court will have liberty to cancel the bail bonds of the petitioner.
