2 23-12-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Shikarpur P.S. Case No. 785 of 2025 registered for the offence under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, the recovery is of total 11.22 litre of illicit liquor from a dustbin.

4. It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and he has falsely been implicated in this case. It is next submitted that chowkidar identified the petitioner as the owner of the illicit liquor. Petitioner has one criminal antecedent.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that



the petitioner is ready to donate Rs. 15,000/- in some charitable organization without accepting his guilt.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts, this application is allowed.

7. Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the concerned Court below within four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, Excise-II, Bettiah, District- West Champaran/ concerned Court below in connection with Shikarpur P.S. Case No. 785 of 2025, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 / Section 482 of the BNSS.

8. This is also subject to the condition that the petitioner shall deposit an amount of Rs. 15,000/- in Ramkrishna Mission Ashrama, Bela, Muzaffarpur and produce the receipt of the same before the Court below. The bail bonds of the petitioner shall be accepted after verifying the genuineness of the receipt produced by the petitioner.

9. As a condition of this order, the petitioner after being released on bail, is directed to mark his attendance at



Shikarpur Police Station, District- West Champaran on any four
Sundays of every month. Any default in appearance at the
Police Station will result in cancellation of bail bonds of the
petitioner.
