The authority shall endeavour to pass necessary orders strictly in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of the copy of this order. It is needless to observe that before passing any order the petitioner shall be given an opportunity of hearing. Any order passed shall be communicated to the party.

3. With the above directions, the present Writ Petition stands disposed of.
