1. Heard the learned advocates for the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. There was a free fight between the parties. Petitioner also suffered grievous injuries as appearing from the injury report. Though one of the injuries is grievous, the fact that incidence occurred in course of a free fight between the parties where petitioner also suffered grievous injuries must be taken into consideration. Hence, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
3. Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/-, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the

conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita and on condition that he shall
appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail
within a period of four weeks from date.

4. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, allowed.
