Since substantial time has passed, petitioner would in the changed circumstances, if faced with similar inconveniences, approach with a fresh prayer before the concerned authorities. The concerned authorities would dispose of the representation of the petitioner in accordance with law.

With the aforesaid observations, the writ petition being WPA 105 of 2024 is disposed of.

Pending connected application, if any, is consequently disposed of.

There will be no order as to costs.
