WB-40AJ/3476 and WB-40AU/9908.

In view of the said Tractors being made available, if the petitioner has other issues to be dealt with, the petitioner would approach the jurisdictional Magistrate by invoking the relevant provisions of law. The learned Magistrate would see to it that whether any criminal offence has been made out and accordingly, pass necessary orders as it deems fit and proper.

With the aforesaid observations, the writ petition being WPA 129 of 2025 is disposed of.
