

5. We further see that 11 out of 28 charge sheet named witnesses have already been examined by the prosecution. The prosecution wants to examine 11 more witnesses. The status report indicates that the trial is likely to conclude within two and a half months.
6. In view of the prima facie incriminating material against the petitioner and seeing that the trial is progressing at a highly satisfactory pace, we are not inclined to allow the petitioner's prayer for bail, at this stage.
7. The prayer for bail is rejected.
8. CRM (DB) 102 of 2025 is dismissed.
