Affidavit-of-service filed on behalf of the
petitioner is taken on record.

Matter relates to transfer of the petitioner since
petitioner is suffering from ailments. An application was
made on Utsashree portal on 4th April, 2022 and same
was processed by the school authority where petitioner is
presently working and was forwarded to the concerned
District Inspector of Schools (S.E.) on 9th April, 2022 for
taking further steps. The concerned District Inspector of
Schools (S.E.) in his turn has processed the transfer
application and forwarded the same on 11th May, 2022 to
the West Bengal Central School Service Commission for
taking final decision.

The grievance of the petitioner is in spite of
receipt of transfer application through portal on 11th

May, 2022, Commission has not taken any decision. Prayer is made to give direction upon the concerned authority of the Commission to decide the transfer application of the petitioner.

Respondents are represented by learned advocates who have jointly submitted that due to suspension of portal contemporaneous decision could not be taken on transfer application of the petitioner.

On behalf of West Bengal Central School Service Commission, it is submitted that if concerned authority is directed, transfer application of the petitioner shall be decided in accordance with law.

Having considered the submissions made on behalf of the parties, writ petition stands disposed of directing the Chairman, West Bengal Central School Service Commission being respondent no.3 to decide the transfer application of the petitioner by eight (8) weeks from the date of communication of this order and the decision to be communicated to the petitioner by one (1) week thereafter.

However, it is made clear that transfer application shall not be rejected on the ground of suspension of portal.

Urgent photostat certified copy of the order, if applied for, be given to the parties, upon usual undertakings.
