1. Heard learned Advocates for both the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Petitioner no.1 is the step daughter-in-law and petitioner no.2 is the step daughter respectively of the de-facto complainant/victim. Allegations against them are general and omnibus. Injury does not appear to be grievous and/or life threatening. Under such circumstances, we are of the opinion custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not necessary and they may be granted anticipatory bail.
3. Accordingly, we direct in the event of arrest, the petitioners, namely, ***(1) Juthika Biswas Sikdar @ Juthi Sikdar @ Juthika Biswas & (2) Ranjita Roy Sikdar @ Sikdar Roy***, be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 and on further

condition that the petitioners shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

4. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
