1. Affidavit of service filed on behalf of the petitioner/applicant is taken on record.
2. This is an application for restoration of the writ petition upon recalling the order dated 10th April, 2025.
3. By the order dated 10th April, 2025, the writ petition was dismissed for default.
4. Mr. Sudhangshu Nath, learned advocate appearing for the petitioner/applicant submits that due to sudden illness, he could not appear on the date, the writ petition was called on. He seeks for restoration of the writ petition upon recalling the order dated 10th April, 2025.
5. Despite service, none appears on behalf of the respondents.
