**C. R. M. (A) 193 of 2025**

In Re: An application for anticipatory bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 filed on 13.01.2025 in connection with Md. Bazar Police Station Case No.355 of 2024 dated 14.12.2024 under Sections 85/115(2)/109/351(2)/3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 read with Sections 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act. (G.R. Case No.1928 of 2024)

1. Heard learned Advocates for both the parties.
2. We have considered the materials on record. Petitioners are the in-laws of the victim-housewife. Allegation of physical assault is not supported by medical evidence. Under such circumstances, we are of the opinion custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not necessary and they may be granted anticipatory bail.
3. Accordingly, we direct in the event of arrest, the petitioners, namely, ***(1) Md. Firoz Hossain & (2) Md. Sukuruddin Mallick***, be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the jurisdictional court and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

4. The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
