The petitioners seek the benefit of an order No. 1215 dated December 3, 2024, issued by the Assistant Registrar of Co-operative Societies, Purba Medinipur-II Range, Contai, whereby employees of certain societies were granted an ad hoc monthly allowance of Rs. 2,000/-.

The petitioners claim that they are similarly circumstanced with the employees who have been provided with such a grant.

It appears that the petitioners made a representation before the Assistant Registrar of Co-operative Societies, Purba Medinipur-II Range, Contai.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that their prayer has not yet been considered.

In light of this, I find no reason to keep this writ petition pending.

Accordingly, I direct the Assistant Registrar of Co-operative Societies, Purba Medinipur-II Range, Contai, to consider the petitioners' representation in accordance with the law within two months from the date of this order, after providing an opportunity for a hearing to the petitioners. A reasoned order should be communicated to the petitioners within seven days thereafter.

Accordingly, **WPA 1231 of 2025** is disposed of.
